Residents' Small Remodeling Disposal

Residents (no contractors) with small "do it yourself" projects can now bring construction material to the scale house of the Covanta Transfer Station and pay just 10 cents a pound.

Acceptable Items: Household Chemicals, oil paint, solvents, auto fluids, batteries, mercury products & aerosol cans, glues, photo chemicals, oven & drain cleaners, mothballs, flea collar products, rechargeable batteries, lighter fluid, & from the yard-pesticides, insecticides, fungicides, poisons, fertilizers & weed killers. Also, gasoline, kerosene, antifreeze, unused motor oil, degreasers, car polish, driveway sealer, pool chemicals. **NO LATEX PAINT.** Latex paint is not hazardous & can be disposed of in your trash. Remove lid, air dry until hard, or add kitty litter or sawdust to speed up drying, go to www.braintree.ma.gov/recycling for additional information.

You can turn in your old **mercury thermostats** at Household Hazardous Waste events, or the Health Department, 90 Pond Street (8:30AM-4:30PM), and receive a new digital, non-mercury version.



There is a **free exchange of mercury thermometers** for a non-mercury digital version at the Health Department at 90 Pond Street or at Hazardous Waste Drop-off events.

For safe transport of mercury items, pack carefully to avoid breakage.
